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Each candidate for the Sacrament of Confirmation must choose a sponsor. A sponsor's role is to be present to the candidate before and after the Sacrament of Confirmation. In choosing a sponsor, Church Law (called Canon Law) gives us some requirements that must be met:

- A sponsor must be at least 16 years of age.
- A sponsor must be a fully-initiated Catholic (one who has received Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) and who "leads a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken." He or she must practice the Catholic Faith by receiving the sacraments often.
- A sponsor must not be bound by any Church penalty (i.e., married outside the Church, such as a civil marriage, or is divorced and then remarried without a Church annulment).
- A sponsor must not be a parent of the one to be confirmed.

It is also important to reflect on the following characteristics when choosing a Sponsor:

- 6-Mar-19Local residency is best (although not required) to ensure consistent involvement throughout the Confirmation process.
- A positive and comfortable relationship with you.
- A willingness and capacity to engage in the Confirmation program.

The person you choose for your sponsor should be willing to participate with you in the preparation for the sacrament. If he or she is not able to do this, you may consider choosing someone to act as a "proxy" for the preparation period. Inviting your sponsor to assist you in your community service project and Sunday Mass will give him or her an opportunity to join with you during this journey, rather than just having them "check up" on you about fulfilling your obligations.
