HB 235 - Abortion

General Bill by Hill (CO-SPONSORS) Beltran;

Hage; Sabatini

Abortion: Requires physician to examine woman obtaining abortion for presence of detectable fetal heartbeat; revises informed consent for abortion procedure requirements; provides criminal penalties; prohibits termination of pregnancy when fetal heartbeat is detected; provides exceptions.

Effective Date: July 1, 2019

Last Event: Filed on Thursday, January 10, 2019
