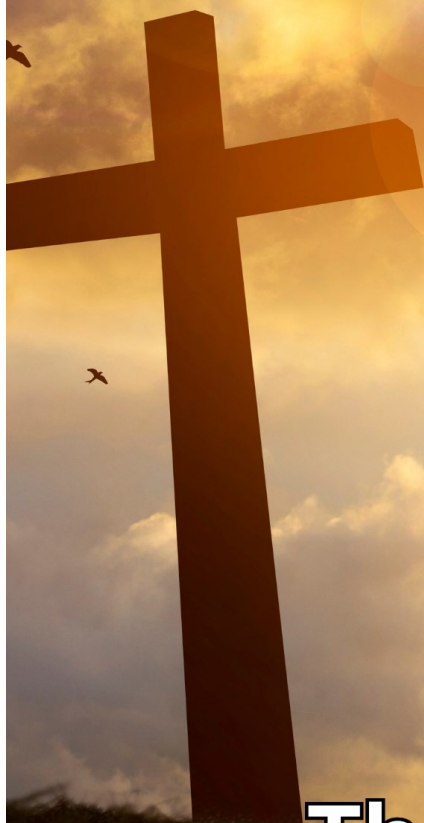

The Body of Christ: Living As a Eucharistic People

Our world and our country are troubled and divided. Many people today are feeling hurt, abandoned, threatened, angry, anxious and/or depressed. The world is in need of hope more than ever. It needs to see that living in peace and harmony are possible...and we, the Church, can provide it to them and lead the way.

In Eucharistic Prayer #2, we pray that by "partaking of the Body of Christ, we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit." St. Paul encourages us to be "in full accord and of one mind." (Phil 2:2). During this Lenten Series and continuing our Eucharistic Revival, we will explore and discuss how we, as the Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic community, can lead the way living as a Eucharistic people "gathered into one by the Holy Spirit."

What are the characteristics of a Eucharistic People? There are many, but we will examine the following five:

What does our prayer life look like? Do we pray like the Pharisee standing at the front of the synagogue using lots of words, but not saying much or do we pray like the repent tax collector kneeling at the back? (Luke 18:9-14) Do we pray by trying to silence our minds so we can listen to God? Lent is a perfect time to examine our prayer life and to engaged deeper with Christ so as to be transformed by our prayer. Let's get together and talk about it.


