Our world and our country are troubled and divided. Many people today are feeling hurt, abandoned, threatened, angry, anxious and/or depressed. The world is in need of hope more than ever. It needs to see that living in peace and harmony are possible...and we, the Church, can provide it to them and lead the way.

In Eucharistic Prayer #2, we pray that by "partaking of the Body of Christ, we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit." St. Paul encourages us to be "in full accord and of one mind." (Phil 2:2). During this Lenten Series and continuing our Eucharistic Revival, we will explore and discuss how we, as the Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic community, can lead the way living as a Eucharistic people "gathered into one by the Holy Spirit."

We all know the reading from Chapter 13 of St. Paul's first letter to the Corinthians...or do we really? And what about this whole thing Jesus taught about loving our enemy...or the unlovable, the homeless and the unnoticed people in our community. 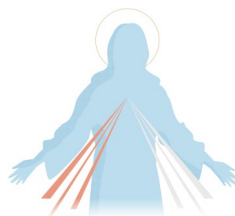
Adult & Family Faith Formation – New Committees Forming
