The Body of Christ: Living As a Eucharistic People

Our world and our country are troubled and divided. Many people today are feeling hurt, abandoned, threatened, angry, anxious and/or depressed. The world is in need of hope more than ever. It needs to see that living in peace and harmony are possible...and we, the Church, can provide it to them and lead the way.

In Eucharistic Prayer #2, we pray that by "partaking of the Body of Christ, we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit." St. Paul encourages us to be "in full accord and of one mind." (Phil 2:2). During this Lenten Series and continuing our Eucharistic Revival, we will explore and discuss how we, as the Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic community, can lead the way living as a Eucharistic people "gathered into one by the Holy Spirit."

We are called to transform our neighbors into the Eucharistic People that God call us to be. But how do we do that especially in a world that does not look too kindly on us Catholics?

Let's once again turn to Sacred Scripture to find the answer and talk it over together.

Ministry Happenings

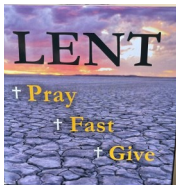

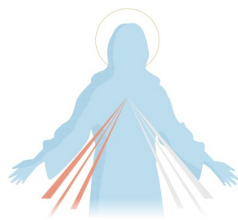

Preparing for Divine Mercy Sunday

(4/7/2024) "[Jesus to Faustina:] My daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given to you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet. When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their

souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one...I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the merciful Savior." (Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska: Divine Mercy in My Soul, 1541) "Say unceasingly the chaplet that I have taught you...Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. I desire that the whole world know My infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy" (Diary, 687). 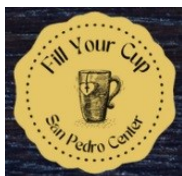
