Holy Week is the most important week in the Catholic Church.

Starting on Palm Sunday going to Holy Saturday, it marks the final days before Easter Sunday, the celebration of Jesus' Resurrection. During this sacred week Catholics pray and reflect on the intense journey of Jesus' suffering, sacrifice, and victory over death. Palm Sunday, a day that commemorates Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. Holy Thursday celebrates the Last Supper and the institution of the Eucharist while Good Friday reflects on Jesus' death by crucifixion. Each day, we reflect on the emotional intensity of Jesus' Passion, think about His boundless love and mercy, and anticipate the joyous hope of His Resurrection. An intentional Holy Week can serve as a spiritual pilgrimage that deepens our faith.



On Good Friday, there is no Mass, but simply Holy Communion from the previous day during the Passion of the Lord service at 3:00pm.

Stations of the Cross - Good Friday March 29th at 12:00pm in the Church. This will be the multimedia version of the Stations of the Cross. With each Station, there is a reflection from the movie, *The Passion of the Christ*. Please be advised, this may not be suitable for small children.


