Holy Week is the most important week in the Catholic Church. Starting on Palm Sunday going to Holy Saturday, it marks the final days before Easter Sunday, the celebration of Jesus' Resurrection. During this sacred week Catholics pray and reflect on the intense journey of Jesus' suffering, sacrifice, and victory over death. Palm Sunday, a day that commemorates Jesus' entry into Jerusalem. Holy Thursday celebrates the Last Supper and the institution of the Eucharist while Good Friday reflects on Jesus' death by crucifixion. Each day, we reflect on the emotional intensity of Jesus' Passion, think about His boundless love and mercy, and anticipate the joyous hope of His Resurrection. An intentional Holy Week can serve as a spiritual pilgrimage that deepens our faith.


