

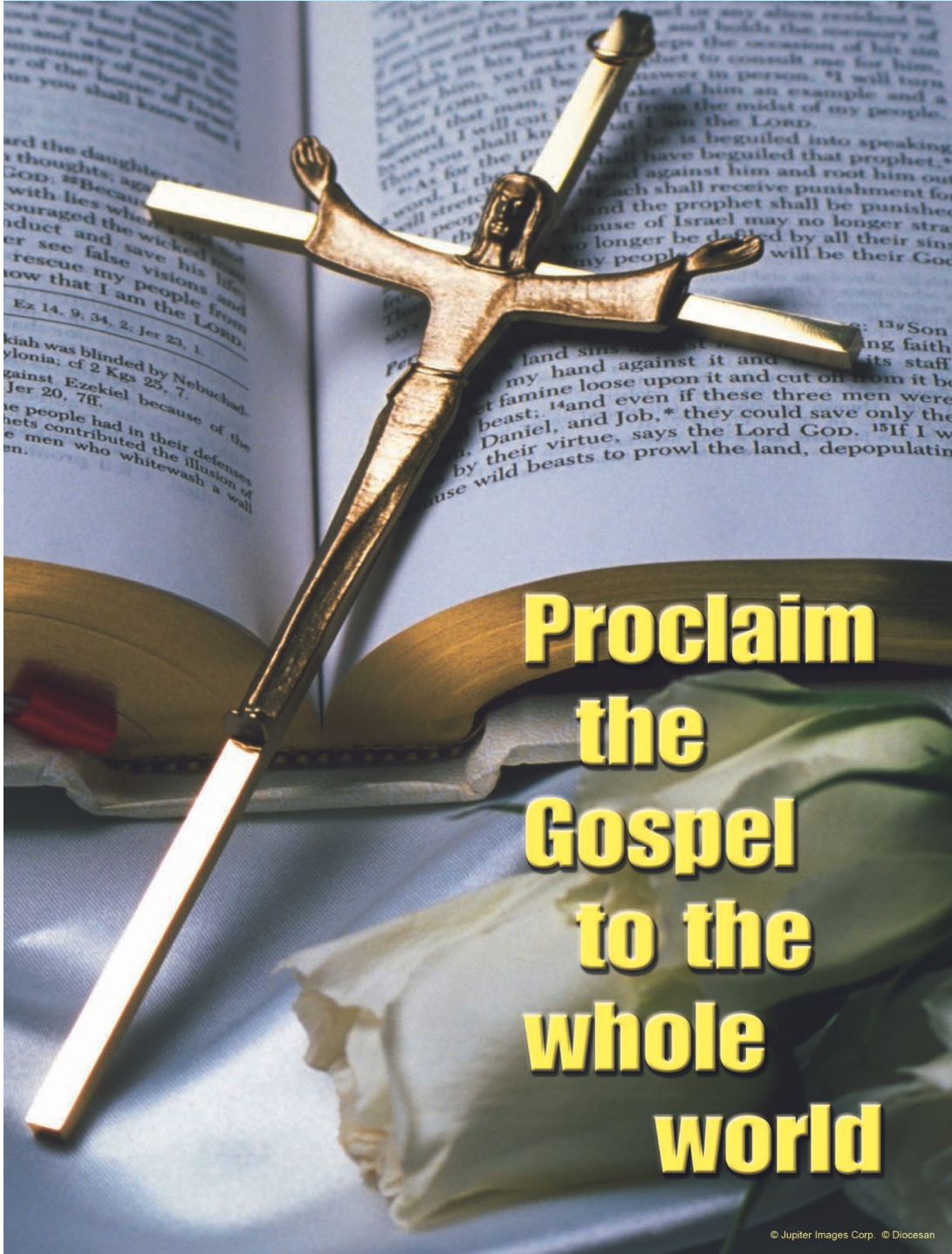

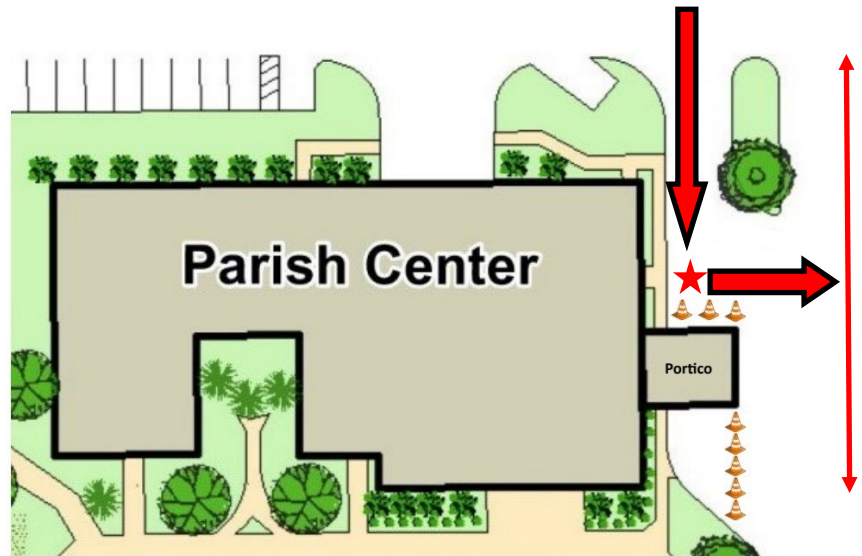

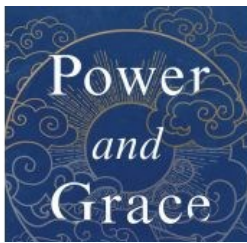

Sunday, May 19th from 1:00pm-3:00pm - Open to all youth 6-12 graders. Food, snacks provided. Bring your own water bottle. We will have

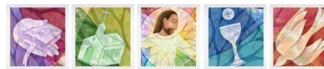
