**Mass Signature Cards** - Weekly Mass attendance is required. The student is to write the name of the Celebrant (Presiding Priest) in the appropriate box. Then, after Mass, a priest or deacon will stamp the card verifying Mass attendance for that week. You are required to turn in each completed card the week following the last date on card. You will need to turn them in to the catechist, Mrs. Maribel or Miss Samantha.

**Prayers** - Prior to receiving the Sacraments, students are expected to memorize and recite all the prayers in their First Communion Prayer book. They will be tested on these prayers.

**1st Communion outfits-**

- Dress shoes should be worn, no sneakers.
- Girls' dresses should cover their shoulders and backs and
- Girls are not to wear gloves.
- Boys may wear suits or a dress shirt, tie and dress slacks.
- No items may be carried; this includes purses, prayer books etc.

**Banners** - Students will design and assemble a banner that will hang on their pew during the First Communion Mass. Banner kits will be distributed prior to the First Communion Retreat.
